

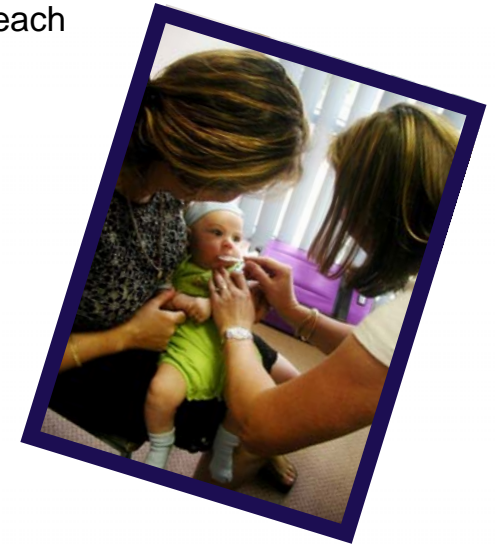


Immunisation Schedule 2014

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

What to bring to a session:

- Your Child Health Record Book. This contains your child's computer number, which will enable quick access to your child's details.
- Medicare Card (for first visit only, if available).
- Your child's comfort device/special toy (if needed).

Following all vaccinations, a waiting period of 15 minutes is recommended in order to observe for any possible reactions.

In the event of a child's illness prior to immunisation, please seek advice from the child's own doctor about the appropriateness of them being vaccinated.

Your child's immunisation records will be forwarded to the Australian Childhood Immunisation Register (ACIR) and will be used to process school entry immunisation certificates and family allowances relating to immunisation.
