

Opportunities for Involvement - Come along for one or more of the following:

Classroom Assistant	Teacher's helper - roles will be decided between you and the teacher. This can include working with 1 child or a small group, helping to set up or pack up activities etc.	Teacher will provide instructions and support.	2 hours or more # Days & times will be negotiated with you.
Literacy Assistant / Listening to Readers	Providing support and encouragement to students who have confidence issues with their reading, writing and/or organisation skills.	On the job training, plus a program to work through with students and ongoing support from the classroom teacher.	1-2 hours, at least 1 or 2 times per week. Days and times to be negotiated.
Breakfast Club, And Brunch Club	Assist with preparation of toast & milk for breakfast &/or healthy salad sandwiches, celery & carrot sticks and fruit ready for children for brunch. Assist with set up and clean up.	Work with a group of volunteers.	Breakfast Club - 8.00am to 9.00am. Brunch Club - 9am to 11.45am. # Days & times will be negotiated with you.
School Excursions	Assist Teachers to supervise students	Teacher will provide instructions and support	1 day, or part of a day, in line with planned excursions.
Sports	Assist the PE & sports teachers with sporting classes and/or sports clubs.	The Sports Teacher will provide instructions and support.	1 or more hours per week. Days and times to be negotiated.
Parents & Friends group	Join this fun, friendly, dynamic group of parents who raise funds for our school and are involved in a range of school activities. Having a say in the development of my children's school.	Support and guidance from Debbie Dodd & other members of the P&F.	Meets 7pm on last Wednesday of each month. Help with activities or projects you choose to become involved with, at times that suit you.
Special Activities	Help with organising or cooking for a family BBQ, participate in cultural days, attend an open day with your child's class, help with the annual fete, supervise a disco etc.	Debbie Dodd &/or staff will provide instructions and support.	Casual - Join the casual volunteers register, to be contacted about events - you can then choose if this is the right opportunity for you!
