We have already been observing some fabulous scientific experiences from the classroom. It is inspiring to see our students making predictions and creating their hypothesis about what might be the resulting reaction to their experiments.

Alongside the scientific aspect, students will look at how actions in everyday life have reactions and consequences. They will explore this through discussion about everyday events, story and across all areas of the curriculum.
